

This photo: Combine several compatible wildflowers in one pot to bring a touch of woodland wonder to a deck or patio. After they are done flowering, plant them in your garden for the following year. This container includes eastern bluebells (*Mertensia virginica*), white wild bleeding heart (*Dicentra eximia* 'Alba'), and bird's-foot violet (*Viola pedata*).

Bark-Wrapped Pots

Tools and Materials

- Terra-cotta container
- Sheets of bark
- Twine or string



1. Select a terra-cotta container large enough to hold your plants.



2. Cut the bark the width of the pot height and long enough to wrap around it.



3. Tie twine around the bark-covered pot.
